Unified Sports Fall Games is a two-day event traditionally held in Conway. Unified Sports Fall Games typically hosts 400 athletes, 150 Unified partners, 200 coaches, and 300 volunteers. This state event is unique because it is a Unified event in which people with and without intellectual disabilities compete together.

- Athletes and Unified Partners can compete in **bocce, flag football, softball, and tennis.**
- **Healthy Athletes** provides free health screenings and education to athletes.
- **Unified Champion Schools** Youth Summit provides a space for UCS to promote inclusion and learn more about SOAR.
- **Young Athletes** is offered to children ages 2-7 to receive an early introduction to sports and to the world of Special Olympics.
