


What does it take to keep Arkansas athletes active in sports each year?

- **\$5,000** provides 1000 medals
- \$6,000 provides equipment needed to host a competition for 1000 athletes
- **\$10,000** provides 100 Young Athletes kit to pre-school or library
- **\$10,000** pays for 10 athletes to attend a USA or World Games competition
- \$20,000 pays for 65 athletes to attend a weekend-long competition or sports camp
- **\$25,000** purchases 1000 uniforms for athletes
